## UNIFORM STANDARDS

### UNIFORM BADGES:

Volunteers are to wear a volunteer badge located at the check in, must be always worn.

### UNIFORM SHIRTS:

All shirts are to be returned at the end of the event. Restaurant storefront will have a specific uniform shirt with logo.

### UNIFORM PANTS:

Khaki pants, mid-thigh length shorts or Capri's.

- Absolutely NO jeans fabric, sweatpants, athletic pants, yoga pants, cargo or baggy shorts
- If you have belt loops, a plain belt MUST be worn

### UNIFORM SHOES:

Must be closed around the entire foot. No open toed shoes, sandals or Crocs.

### UNIFORM HATS:

Food safety you MUST wear a hat or hair net in food prep area.

- Snappers, Miami Marlins or plain (no logo) hats are acceptable
- Absolutely NOT to be worn backwards, sideways, upside down or around the neck
- Hair longer than shoulder length MUST be in a braid or bun
- All hair must be pulled away from the face and under the hat

### ABSOLUTELY NO REFERENCES TO OTHER TEAMS

- With GSEG preapproval, NPO groups may wear their team hat, it must be identical to all in their group.

### JEWELRY:

NO excessive jewelry and NO facial piercings; no visible tattoos.

- Except for a plain ring such as a wedding band, while preparing food, food employees may not wear jewelry including medical information jewelry on their arms and hands food safety.
- Earrings cannot be larger than dime size.
